





Planning of a workshop (1)

1. Agreement with partner organization about expenses, equipment, places, target group recruitment, time schedule, etc
2. Try getting information about the participants, age, technical skills...
3. Workshop length: (LA Story model, 7-10 participants, 2 facilitators): 20-22hours
 - Introduction: 1 hour
 - Creative exercises: 1 hour
 - Script writing 1: $\frac{1}{2}$ hour
 - Story Circle 1: 1 hour 30 minutes
 - Story Circle 2: 1 hour
 - Scriptwriting 2: $\frac{1}{2}$ hour
 - Voice recording: expect 20 minutes-30 minutes per participant (4-5 hours total)
 - “How to” sessions: 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ hour
 - Picture and sound hunting on the internet: 2 hours
 - Sound mixing (for ex. Audacity): 2 hours
 - Video editing: 4 hours
 - Celebration: 1 hour

Planning of a workshop (2)

4. After the workshop:


- Evaluation from participants
- Evaluation from facilitators
- Making of dvd and diploma/certificate
- Contact with participants for further involvement
- Publishing of stories on the web (if allowed)
- Contact with partner organization for further workshops

Equipment needed:

- 1 PC or Mac per participant, equipped with audio & video software, 1 facilitator computer
- 1 USB microphone
- 1 Canon projector
- Good headphones
- Internet connection!
- Digital camera
- Scanner
- Pens, paper, etc
- Whiteboard
- Earphone sharing plugs
- External hard drives, USBs
- Coffee, tea, fruit, lunch etc
